The Best Setting

Our home is the beautiful campus of California State University Channel Islands near Camarillo.

CSUCI has 630 acres located next to the foothills of the Santa Monica Mountains. With only 2,000 students and no summer school, it is a tranquil oasis surrounded by farm land and orchards. It is located less than three miles from the coast so it will be cool all summer.

The Dorm is only four years old and has world class facilities. Campers are housed in two bedroom suites that a bathroom. Adult counselors provide supervision and help for camper needs. There is a pool in the dorm complex so campers can cool off after training or games.

The dining hall has a selection of food with many healthy choices at every meal. Each day the camp provides three meals and an evening snack.

A new gym and playing fields are just a few steps from the dorms. All the training will be on a field so large that is equal to three soccer fields. The grass is outstanding.

The campus is the perfect setting for our camp training and outstanding staff.

The Soccer Academy offers an outstanding program that is now in its 39th year. Academy alumni include All Americans, U.S. National Team members, and many players who have competed in college.

Directing is Alan Meeder, nationally recognized coach, author, and master teacher. Alan was twice a collegiate coach of the year. He has conducted courses in 30 states and certified over 9,000 coaches. He has appeared in seven soccer training videos and he was technical advisor for a feature film starring Pele.



Basic Session

This session is specifically designed to introduce players 8-10 to the live-in experience and teach valuable skills on and off the field. These sessions are perfect for players in their first two years of playing. At this age, players must learn the correct techniques that will serve as a base for the rest of their careers. The skills are taught using fun games, drills, and scrimmages under the supervision of our staff coaches.

Advanced Sessions

Advanced is open to players 10 and older who have mastered the basics. Some of the best junior players from Southern California and other states will be there and you can be part of the action. These weeks concentrate on taking advanced techniques and tactics and performing them in real game situations. The Advanced Sessions sell out every year.

Goalkeeping Sessions

The Soccer Academy offers total keeper coaching that includes the technical, tactical, and psychological training you need. Demonstrations and drills are used to reinforce skills; but the real benefits come from the competitions, small sided scrimmages, and full games against field players. There are separate weeks for 10-13 year olds and High School players. Keepers and field players train in their specialty during the day and scrimmage together in the evening. By the end of the week our coaches will have you getting to crosses that you couldn't touch and saving shots that you thought were unstoppable.



High School Week

Minimum age for this camp is 14. Last year five former pro players and five college coaches on our staff shared their experience with our campers. Expect a week that will challenge your skills and prepare you for higher competition. A variety of off field activities include college counseling sessions and an end of the week pizza party and dance.





Enrollment

The 2012 sessions of The Soccer Academy will be held near Camarillo at Cal State Univ Channel Islands. The all-inclusive tuition is \$575.00 for Basic Sessions, \$595.00 for Advanced, High School, and Goalkeeping. Day Camp tuition for all sessions is \$325.00 and includes lunch and dinner. All Campers receive a Score soccer ball and T-shirt.

Reservations are made on a first come-first served basis upon receipt of the \$100.00 nonrefundable deposit and a completed application and health form. Tuition balances are due by June 1st. Campers will receive a confirmation letter containing a clothing list and directions to the camp. Checks should be made payable to THE SOCCER ACADEMY. The Best Coaches

Our staff is composed of college, ODP, U.S. Junior National Team coaches and professional players. They are carefully chosen for their knowledge of the game and ability to work with young players. Last summer 5 former professional players and 14 college coaches shared their insights and experience with our campers.

At the beginning of each session **players are placed in groups by age and ability**. Within the Academy's curriculum, each group trains at it's own level to challenge every camper. Evening games are played daily to take newly learned skills and put them into the competitive context. The result is a program that refines technical ability and tactical awareness.

On Friday morning, campers meet with their coach and receive a **full written evaluation**. This evaluation provides campers with a professional's assessment of their strengths and areas to work on to improve for the next season.
